

**PLEASE REVIEW THESE GUIDELINES
BEFORE MAKING YOUR RESERVATION**

1. **“Rolling Maximum Reservation Limit.”** No more than three reservations per Member may be in effect at any one time. New rule effective July 1, 2007.
2. **Reservation Cut-off.** Reservations close at 4 pm on the day before the day of use. After 4 pm the daily reservation list will be posted at the check-in kiosk to show the unreserved training areas that can be signed up for on the day of use on a first come first served basis.
3. **Cancellations.** Always cancel a reservation you won't be using. You can cancel at any time via the web site, even after the reservation cut-off time. *PLEASE DON'T FORGET TO CANCEL.*
4. **Half-Day and Full-Day Use.** Reservations are for half day periods. Members of a training group may not combine reservations to hold the same training area under reservation for an entire day. However, if an area is still open for the other half of the day, you can keep it by signing up for it at the check-in kiosk.
5. **Pond Area Reservations.** You may reserve only one pond training area per day. Members of a training group may not combine reservations to hold one or more pond training areas under reservation for an entire day. If you wish to train in pond training areas for the entire day, you can sign up on arrival at the check-in kiosk for any pond training area that is still open. The Denverton pond training areas that are under this restriction are T1 and T2. The Goose Lake pond training areas that are under this restriction except when dry are T1, T5, T9, T10, and Tumblin and Houchin Lakes.
6. **Early Departures.** If the Member who made the reservation leaves the training group, other Members of the training group may continue to use that training area until the end of the reserved time. If all members of the training group leave the training area early, please mark the posted reservation list so later drop-ins know that your area is again open for use.
7. **No Lead Shot.** No lead shot on CRTA training properties. New rule effective July 1, 2007.
8. **Guests.** If you wish to bring guest trainers, please see the complete rules covering guest use in the [CRTA Role and Rules](#). Hosts must collect the appropriate fee from guest trainers and must be present with guests at all times. All guests whether training or not must sign the hold harmless agreement available at the check-in kiosk.
9. **Event Priority.** CRTA-approved scheduled Events (field trials, hunt tests, etc.) have priority for training areas. There are training areas still available at Goose Lake during Events, but usually not at Denverton because it is a smaller facility. To select a training area during an Event at Goose Lake, talk to grounds manager Brian Clasby.
10. **Camping.** Dry camping in CRTA camping areas is by reservation made with the grounds manager. Camping during Events is arranged through the hosting club. Complete rules covering camping are in the [CRTA Role and Rules](#).
